Your entire record book must be in a digital slide-show or turn-page format. There is no maximum number of projects that you can include in the Digital Record Book. You may be as creative as you like, inserting photos, clip art, background music, audio and/or video clips.

- _____ 1. **Title page** (include your name, grade, club you belong to, parent/guardian name and year)
- _____ 2. **Project Listing:** List Projects you worked on in the current year.
- _____ 3. **My 4-H Story**
 - a. memorable things that happened in 4-H
 - b. Things you learned and how you will apply your new learning
 - c. What you most enjoyed in 4-H
 - d. What 4-H means to you
 - e. Experiences at club meetings, community service, project experience, events, fair, etc.
- _____ 4. **My 4-H Goals:** Make a listing of your goals and notate dates goals were completed
- _____ 5. **Projects:** A project is an overall area of interest you signed up for at the beginning of year vs. an "exhibit" which is what you actually took to the fair. Feel free to use the traditional project sheets as a guide to what you should include:
 - a. What you plan to do in this project
 - b. What you did
 - c. Skills learned / improved
 - d. What helped you
 - e. Exhibits in this project
 - f. Animal records (if applicable)
 - g. Expenses
 - h. How was the project worthwhile to you
- _____ 6. **Parent Guardian Comments:** Can be typed quotes, audio or video interviews
- _____ 7. **Organization / Project / Youth Leader Comments:** Can be typed quotes, audio or video interviews

3 = All elements included (animal records may not apply)
2 = Missing 1 element
1 = Missing more than 1 elements
0 = Only including 1 element

Scoring

Title Page:

3 = Name, club and grade included
0 = Name, club or grade is missing

Project Listing

3 = All projects in record book included
0 = Missing any projects included in record book

My 4-H Story

3 = All elements included (a-e)
2 = Missing 2 elements
1 = Missing 3-4 elements
0 = Only including 1 element

Goals

3 = Goals & dates are clearly & richly defined
2 = Goals & dates are simply stated
1 = Goals are not clear or some dates are missing
0 = Goals are missing
