LEADING LINES

Photographers:

- ◇ Leading lines are objects in your photo that direct a viewer's eye right to your subject
- ◇ Look for background items that could serve as a leading line like fences, stairs, and bridges
- ◇ Create your own leading line with props like an umbrella, a book, or your own arms



Tips for Mastery:

- ◇ Find leading lines that lead not just to your subject, but the focal point of your subject
- ◇ Have your leading line lead from the foreground to the background
- ◇ Place your subject where two leading lines converge
