LEADING LINES

Photographers:

- Leading lines are objects in your photo that direct a viewers eye right to your subject
- Look for background items that could serve as a leading line like fences, stairs, and bridges
- Create your own leading line with props like an umbrella, a book, or your own arms









Tips for Mastery:

- Find leading lines that lead not just to your subject, but the focal point of your subject
- Have your leading line lead from the foreground to the background
- Place your subject where two leading lines converge
