*Set your own flash to avoid harshly lit photos or too dark photos

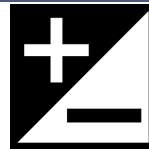
Manual* settings on DSLR cameras

Symbol	Exposure Mode
	Full Auto
	Portrait
	Landscape
	Close-Up
	Sports
	Night Portrait

*Pre-set options on your camera that provide the best settings for certain situations

What other settings can you find on your camera?

P	Programmed Auto / Program Mode Camera Pairs aperture and shutter speed but you can change the settings
A OR Av	Aperture Priority Mode You set the aperture, and the camera sets the shutter speed
S OR Tv	Shutter Priority Mode You set the shutter speed, and the camera sets the aperture
M	Manual Mode You set shutter speed, aperture, and ISO but the camera still gives a meter reading



*Exposure compensation for white or black subjects or unique lighting situations

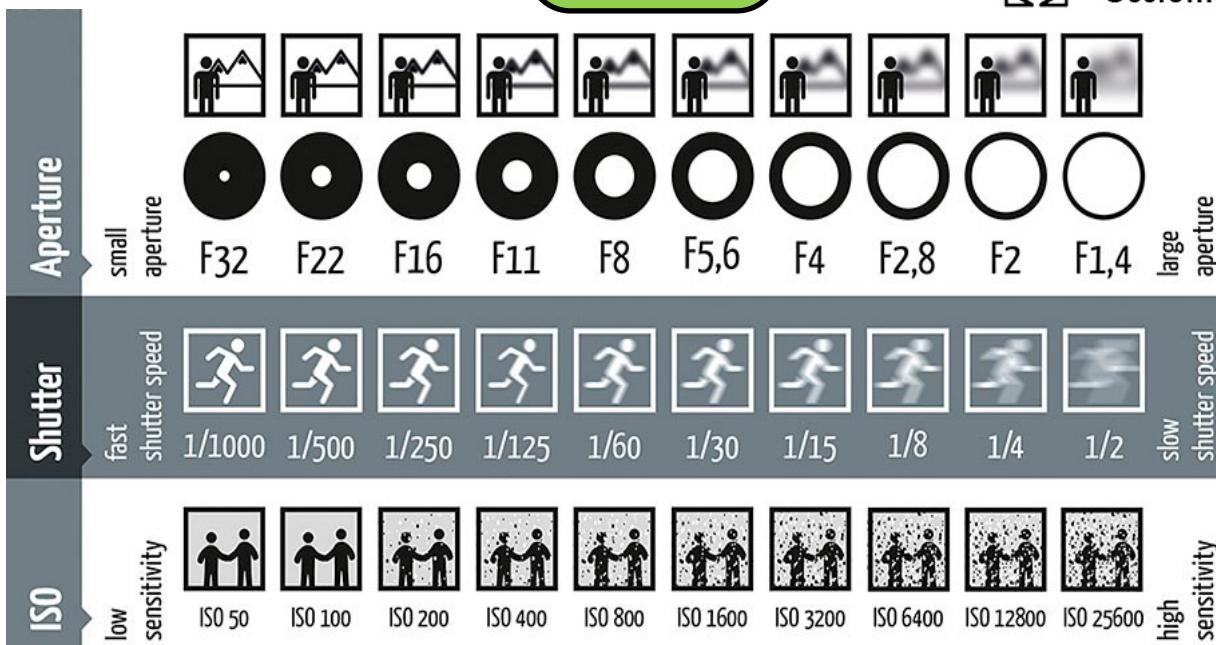
