The two Adult Recommendations should be sent directly to the Extension Office and be received by **December 3, 2021**. It is helpful to include a pre-addressed, stamped envelope with your recommendation form when giving it to the person writing the recommendation. It is also recommended that you follow up with your references to ensure that they have completed your form and sent it in on time.

When applying to be a Summer 4-H Camp Jr. Director, keep in mind that your commitment is beyond the one week of summer when camp occurs. The Jr. Director position is a **huge** responsibility and requires commitment to attend all planning meetings. You will have an active role in many of the camp trainings as well as during camp activities. Please be sure to read the Jr. Director position description completely and carefully consider the commitment this position will require.

All summer camp Jr. Director applicants must be registered 4-H members in 12th or 13th grade at the time their application is submitted and have at least 2-3 years (realizing there was no camp in 2020) experience as a camp counselor.

4-H Summer Camp Jr. Director Position Description

The Junior Director works closely with the Extension Staff (Camp Coordinators) and Adult Volunteer Advisors to plan camp and trainings. He/She will also assist with developing the overall camp schedule and planning large group activities. This truly is a huge leadership opportunity for the Junior Director.

Before Camp

- Be familiar with the camp policies and procedures.
- Be familiar with the jobs of the advisors, counselors and chaperones (camp staff)
- Attend all required trainings.
- Provide input and feedback with planning of training and camp schedules
- Prepare introductions or icebreakers for meetings.
- Assist counselors with questions.
- Review Lesson plans to become familiar with camp activities being offered

During Camp

- Post schedules and assignments.
- o Lead camper orientation.
- o Lead morning flag raising.
- o Make daily announcements and call in / dismiss groups to various activities throughout the day based on schedule.
- o Help engage and encourage counselors in their roles as needed.
- o Help engage campers in their activities as needed.
- Address camper questions as they arise.
- Visit camper activities throughout the day
- o Report back to Extension Staff, Adult Volunteer Advisors or Chaperones any areas of concern or question.
- o Make any final announcements for the day.

For all Youth Counselors & Jr. Director, there are the following expectations:

- All positions are expected to provide a safe, inclusive camp experience
- Promote Summer Camp at your 4-H Club and at least one other club through a formal presentation. This can be done individually or in a small group.
- There will be a mandatory team building FUNdraiser to assist in camp costs. Date to be determined.
- All positions are required to participate in pre- and post-camp activities.
