The WI 4-H Key Award is the highest 4-H recognition you can receive. 4-H Key Award applicants must have:

- 1. Consistent 4-H growth
- Be a 4-H youth in 9th grade or older
 Must have completed at least 3 years of 4-H
- 4. 1 year of youth leadership
- 5. Contributed to service to their club, community, and county.

Requirements:

- 1. Turn in a completed application by deadline
- 2. Two completed reference forms
- 3. At least one 4-H record book within the last 3 years
- 4. Key Award Interview
