- a. 4-H Program Coordinator (Dana Berger)
 - i. State 4-H Updates
 - 1. For the most recent 4-H policies visit the Extension website.
 - 2. Annual Expense Reports are due to the Extension Office by September 1st. Instructions and forms were mailed out in early July.
 - 3. The deadline to register for the National 4-H Congress is August 1st.
 - ii. Extension Office Updates
 - 1. Interviews for the Horticulture position are taking place in the last week of July.
 - 2. Re-enrollment is currently planned to open the Tuesday after Labor Day (September 6th). New this year there are additional pathways to 4-H Membership.
 - a. Horse & Pony Project, Dog Project, and Dairy project are charted as clubs. Youth that are interested in ONLY participating in these areas can sign up for these as their only club, if youth would like to participate in other projects (i.e. to fair) will also need to sign up for a traditional club.
 - b. In classroom clubs will be a way to reach youth who experience barriers to joining a traditional community club. Winnebago, Milwaukee and the Menominee Tribe have received a 4-H Foundation grant to bring ChickQuest to local schools. This is a curriculum that teaches students the life cycle of a chicken, embryology and WI agriculture by hatching chickens in the classroom. This is a 6 week program and youth who participate will automatically become 4-H members. This

is for any 3rd or 4th grade teacher that teaches in Winnebago County can request the program.

- iii. Educational Program Reports and Updates
 - County Fair: Please sign up to help with the 4-H Dipper and Basket Raffle using Signup Genius. Sign up for Spotlight Stage on Signup Genius. Fashion Revue is on Wed, Aug 3rd at 4 p.m. in the Expo building. The 4-H Historical Display and 4-H Informational Display will be located in the Expo Building. Chalkboards will be available for Chalk on the Boardwalk. Dogs in Costume Parade is Thrus, Aug 4th at 2p.m. on the road behind the Expo. Daycare Tour Activity Tables will be Wed, Thurs, Fri 9-11 in Expo. YAC Activity tables will be in Expo. Horse & Pony Project activities will be Thurs @ 10 a.m by round pen, Sun @ 1 p.m. by round pen, and Daily Trivia at the Horse Superintendent's Office.
