In 2022, over 64,000 individuals were on community supervision in Wisconsin. Despite the prerelease planning and case management offered at correctional facilities, many individuals find themselves unprepared for the responsibilities and expectations that follow release. The Reentry Ready website is designed to assist individuals in navigating their reentry journey. The site offers local and statewide resources covering a range of topics including financial education, employment, health and housing.
