These youth help make the Winnebago County 4-H Program a success! Thank you for all you do!

Emily Hunter

Emily Hunter is a member of Golden Oak 4-h Club. She served as a Winnebago County 4-H Camp Counselor during 2023 and 2024. During her role as a camp counselor, Emily helped to provide a safe and inclusive camp experience, attended camp planning meetings and trainings, treated the campers, fellow counselors and adult chaperones with respect and helped promote summer camp to youth in her club and community. 
