#### Suggested Club Officer's Duties

**President:** Presides at meetings; distributes responsibility; represents group at county's meetings; shares information from County Business (Executive Board) Meetings and mailings; helps secretary and leaders to get reports in on time; encourages participation in county programs.

**Vice President:** Responsible for program planning in club; in charge of club's subscription to **UPDATE**; assumes duties of president in case of their absence.

**Secretary:** Has charge of roll; keeps the minutes of meetings; handles all club correspondence; responsible for writing reports of all club correspondence; responsible for writing reports of all club activities; sends minutes to Extension Winnebago Co. Office.

<u>Helpful Hints:</u> When mentioning the name of a club member in the minutes, be sure to include both their first and last name. When listing names of new members, be sure to give their full name and, if applicable, their spouse's name as well. Include their complete address, including city and zip code. **Treasurer:** Handles all records pertaining to money; collects dues and Pennies for Friendship; advises club on fund raising needs and other financial status matters.
